

## Allen Township Trustees

**April 1, 2014**

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with Huffman and Stacy present. The minutes of March 11, 2014 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$20,616.93. Huffman moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Stacy. Roll call - all yes.

The Fiscal Officer presented an Amended Resolution to reduce the previous permanent appropriated amount of \$2,862,950.75 by \$1,097.87 to an adjusted \$2,861,852.88. The adjustment was necessitated by a reduction in the anticipated 2014 Local Government Funds for 2014. Huffman moved to adopt the resolution and Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes

Arron Scazny was in attendance to present an Eagle Scout project proposal to revitalize the Sportsplex signs on TR229 and SR 613. The cost would be zero to the Township. After reviewing the written proposal, Huffman moved to accept the proposal with Stacy seconding the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Schimmoeller advised the annual notice of liquor permit renewals has been received if the Trustees would like to object to any of the liquor permits that exist in Allen Township now is the time to do it. After a brief discussion no action was taken.

Tony Humphrey presented a proposal from Findlay Implement to trade-in one of the cemetery lawn mowers at a boot price of \$2,000.00. Stacy moved to accept the proposal with Huffman seconding the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Stacy advised that he has reviewed the new OTARMA insurance policy and everything seemed to be in good order.

Huffman presented a resolution regarding Allen Township's recommendation to the County Commissioners to have the Blanchard River cleaned in an effort to improve flooding in the county. Huffman moved to approve the resolution with Stacy seconding the motion. Roll call – all yes.
