

Allen Township Trustees

May 6, 2014

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members in attendance.

The minutes of April 1, 2014 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$32,981.93. Stacy moved to pay these bills with Huffman seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Resident Jeff Deiter was in attendance to make the Trustee's aware that semi-trucks are running up and down TR215 from Whirlpool to MBDS on SR12. The Trustees took this under advisement and will contact Whirlpool to discuss it and will look into what else may be done.

Arron Scazny was in attendance to advise that his Eagle Scout project to revitalize the Sportsplex signs on TR229 and SR 613 has been completed. Chairman Flanagan signed the Eagle Scout documents certifying that the project has been completed.

Dick Kelly was in attendance to voice his concern over truck traffic on township roads, specifically TR-230.

Hickman advised that the fire extinguishers have all been checked. He advised that a letter from ISO dated 4/28/14 was received regarding this year's fire protection status/certification. Basically the rating for the Allen Township Volunteer Fire Department remained unchanged at a 5/5x. He also advised that the oldest grass fire truck is beginning to continually have repair issues and recommends having it replaced soon. He will be researching the cost of a new truck.

The Fiscal Officer presented the Abstract of Driver Records to the Trustees for all Township personnel who may be in a position to drive Allen Township vehicles. After a brief review of the driving records by the Trustees no action was taken.

Flanagan presented several chip& seal estimates from Whitta Construction.

Huffman moved that the estimate from Whitta Construction in the amount of \$6,000 - \$7,000 to perform crack filling on TR-230 between TR-108 to TR-99. Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Stacy moved that the estimate from Whitta Construction in the amount of \$37,545 to chip and seal TR-142 between TR-107 to TR-99. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Flanagan moved that the estimate from Whitta Construction in the amount of \$42,500 to chip and seal TR-142 between SR-613 to TR-107. Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Stacy moved that a 42" dipping bucket be purchased for the township backhoe. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Meeting adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
