

## **Allen Township Trustees**

**August 5, 2014**

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present. The minutes of July 15, 2014 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$65,923.72. Huffman moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Stacy. Roll call - all yes.

Township residents George Naugle and Andy Smith were in attendance to express concern regarding a potential drainage issue on TR141. There appears to be a couple of building lots just north of TR114 that may soon have houses built on them. Their joint concern is that once these houses are built it could change the flow of surface drainage resulting in flooding on their properties. The Trustees advised the residents that drainage matters off of Township Road ROW are outside their jurisdiction.

Hickman advised that the ATVFD has completed the first combined training with the City of Findlay and the second training session is being scheduled. The hydrant flushing has been completed for the year.

Flanagan advised that the County has completed putting up all of the new road signs.

The Fiscal Officer advised that Allen Township's hearing with the Hancock County Budget Commission will be 8/12/14 at 11:00 a.m. in Jury Room #1 at the Hancock County Courthouse.

The next regular meeting will be September 2, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.
