

## Allen Township Trustees

April 6, 2021

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session with all members present.

Joe Fenimore was in attendance on behalf of the Meadow Ridge Home Owners Association (48 home owners) to advise the Trustees of a drainage situation with their retention pond and the horse farm next to the subdivision. The issue is water from a horse pasture field is being directed toward the Meadow Ridge retention pond. The home owners utilize the pond for recreational purposes and are concerned about water from the pasture field draining into it. Flanagan has researched the situation a bit with Hancock Soil & Water and the county engineer's office and shared his findings with Joe and the home owners that were present. Hancock Soil & Water is looking into the situation.

Reed Hubb was in attendance to introduce himself and present the Trustees a quote to do some grading and seeding in the Hillcrest Subdivision.

Jeff Ramp with the VBCSA was in attendance to give the Trustees an update on the sportsplex group. They are currently doing well and working with the health department to confirm the concession stand is being operating appropriately. He also discussed several upgrade and maintenance issues at the facility.

The minutes of March 2, 2021 were read and approved.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$79,193.61. Huffman moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Flanagan. Roll call - all yes.

Schimmoeller presented an Amended 2021 Township Annual Permanent Appropriation Resolution to include OPWC funds (\$33,799.48) that were granted to resurface TR 108 (CR220 to TR 229). Flanagan moved to adopt the resolution with Huffman seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Schimmoeller presented an Authorization For Hancock County To Contract Pavement Marking Of Township Roads Resolution with American Roadway Logistics in the of \$15,861.00 for restriping sections of TR-99, 142, 215, 218, 229, and 230. Flanagan moved to adopt the resolution with Huffman seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman provided an update on the township fire operations.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on road maintenance activities for the past month. He presented a quote for trading in a 2019 Toro Z cemetery lawn mower for a 2021 Toro Z mower from Casey's Sales & Service for \$2,500.00. Stacy moved to accept the quote from Casey's Sales & Service for \$2,500.00. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes
