

Allen Township Trustees

July 6, 2021

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of June 1, 2021 were read and approved.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$39,418.58 for outstanding bills. Huffman moved to pay these bills with Flanagan seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Flanagan brought up the American Rescue Plan (ARP) and the potential for Allen Township to participate in this funding. After a brief discussion, Huffman moved that the Fiscal Officer process the appropriate forms etc. to have Allen Township participate in the ARP.

Flanagan brought up the opening of the Township Center for outside rentals effective August 1st. The Fiscal Officer advised that he has received two requests for August dates. A significant amount of discussion regarding future public use of the Allen Township Center by both individuals and groups in a post COVID environment. A big concern is sanitation between uses and the cost to do so effectively. Huffman moved that rental rates be changed effective September 1, 2021 to \$200 for residents and \$400 for non-residents. Flanagan seconded the motion. All yes.

Fire Chief Hickman gave an update on the fire department operations.

The 2022 Tax Budget Hearing was held. Huffman moved to submit the 2022 Estimate of Revenues of \$4,010,898 as presented by the Fiscal Officer, to the Budget Commission and to adopt the Estimate of Revenues for the 2022 budget year. Flanagan seconded. Roll call all yes.

Meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
