

Allen Township Trustees

September 7, 2021

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of August 3, 2021 were read and approved.

James May was in attendance to request a deed transfer in the Bechtel Cemetery.

Judge Stephany Bishop was in attendance to introduce herself to the trustees and ask for their support in the Fall election.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$242,564.31 for outstanding bills. Huffman moved to pay these bills with Flanagan seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Schimmoeller advised that the American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds in the amount of \$114,650.04 were received from the Hancock County Auditor on 8/23/2021. A new fund "American Rescue Plan" has been established to properly account for these monies from the Federal Government to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses.

Schimmoeller presented an Amended 2021 Township Annual Permanent Appropriation Resolution to include the recently received ARP funds (\$114,650.04). Flanagan moved to adopt the resolution with Huffman seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Stacy and Schimmoeller met with the Hancock County Budget Commission on August 25th. The Fiscal Officer presented a Resolution Accepting the 2022 Amounts and Rates as Determined By the Budget Commission and Authorizing the Necessary Tax Levies and Certifying them to the County Auditor. Stacy moved for the adoption of the resolution with Flanagan seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman gave an update on the fire department operations.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on road maintenance activities for the past month. He advised the new 2022 Freightliner dump truck/snow plow has been delivered.

The Trustees and Fiscal Officer received an e-mail from Christina Muryn (Mayor of Findlay) on 9/2/2021 regarding a proposed Master Agreement for Revenue Sharing between Allen Township and the City of Findlay. After much discussion on this topic, no action was taken.

Meeting adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
