

# Allen Township Trustees

**October 5, 2021**

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of September 7, 2021 were read and approved.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$37,606.51. Huffman moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Flanagan. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman gave an update on the fire department operations. Gary presented a quote to purchase 11 new pagers from Radio Hospital for approximately \$7,700. Flanagan moved to accept the quote and purchase the new pagers. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes. Gary reviewed the recent ISO Community Classification report for Allen Township. Allen township’s ISO rating has improved from the 2019 score of 05/5X to 2021 score of 04/4Y.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on the road maintenance and the cemetery activities.

Flanagan moved that the County Engineer be the issuer of utility/excavation and oversize load permits for 2022 on behalf of Allen Township. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

The recommended 2022 Sign Program for Allen Township was received from the County Engineer. The “Required” sign maintenance estimate is \$1,200. The “Optional” sign maintenance estimate is \$300. Flanagan moved to authorize the County Engineer to perform both maintenance recommendations for 2022. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

The Trustees and Fiscal Officer received a follow up e-mail from Christina Muryn (Mayor of Findlay) on 9/20/2021 regarding a proposed Master Agreement for Revenue Sharing between Allen Township and the City of Findlay. After minimal discussion on this topic, no action was taken.

The next regular meeting will be November 2, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.
