

# Allen Township Trustees

**April 5, 2022**

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 8:00 a.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present. The minutes of March 1, 2022 were read and approved as read.

Fire Chief Hickman provided an update on the fire department operations. He advised that one of the furnaces at station #1 is having issues.

Hickman presented a \$1.34 million estimate for a new Pierce ladder/pumper truck. The state bid price is good until 4/30/22. After that time the price will go up by 7%. Half of the cost would need to be put down to get the order in for a 23-25 month delivery time. The existing ladder truck is a 1988 piece of equipment that was purchased several years ago from Fostoria. It is showing it's age and developing mechanical issues. The new truck would replace the 1988 ladder truck and the 1992 Ford pumper truck. Flanagan moved to accept the bid with Smith seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on the road maintenance and the cemetery. He advised the Spring cemetery clean up and road birming has been started.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$50,864.72 for outstanding bills. Stacy moved to pay these bills with Smith seconding. Roll call - all yes

Schimmoeller advised the annual notice of liquor permit renewals was received. If the Trustees would like to object to any of the liquor permits that exist in Allen Township now is the time to do it. After a brief discussion no action was taken.

Flanagan presented two requests (VB Lions Club and BS Troop 313) to waive rental fees on the Allen Township Center for their regular meetings. Smith moved to grant the requests with Stacy seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes

Flanagan presented a quote from Unilliance Inc. to chip and seal TR 218 (SR 613 to TR 232) for \$39,960.00. Stacy moved to accept the quote with Smith seconding. Roll call - all yes

Flanagan presented a quote from Griffin Pavement Striping to stripe TR 218 (SR 613 to TR 232) for \$2,208.75. Stacy moved to accept the quote with Smith seconding. Roll call - all yes

Stacy presented a \$27.70 bill from Aqualawn Irrigation to repair a damaged sprinkler head that was damaged by the snowplow this winter at 1645 Deer Creek Drive. Flanagan moved to pay for the damaged sprinkler head. Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes

Stacy moved that the regular meeting time for the remainder of the year be moved to 8:00 p.m. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes

Meeting adjourned at 10:50 a.m.

The next regular meeting will be May 3, 2022 at 8:00 p.m.
