

Allen Township Trustees

July 5, 2022

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 8:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of June 7, 2022 were read and approved.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$232,841.11 for outstanding bills. Stacy moved to pay these bills with Smith seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Schimmoller presented a Resolution drafted by the Hancock County Solid Waste Management Policy Committee to appoint Milford (Joe) Smith to serve as township representative on the Hancock County Solid Waste Management Policy Committee. Flanagan moved to adopt the resolution with Stacy seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman gave an update on the fire department operations.

A quote from Kenn-Feld Group LLC was presented to purchase a 2022 JD Z930M ZTrak 60" Deck mower for the Cemetery. The quote reflects the State Bid price of \$9,473.06. Stacy moved to purchase the new 2022 JD Z930M ZTrak 60" Deck mower for \$9,473.06 for the Cemetery and keep the existing 2020 JD ZTrack mower for use at Fire Station #2. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

An estimate was presented from Brad's Body Shop to repair fire truck #238 for \$894.36. The damage was caused by the township backhoe while on the scene of an accident. Stacy moved to accept the estimate with Smith seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on road maintenance activities for the past month. He advised the door window on the JD road mower was broken by a tree limb and is in for replacement.

The Trustees gave their monthly activity reports.

A proposed Findlay water line extension on TR 218 was discussed. The Trustees are very concerned about the road drainage tile along TR 218 being compromised with any water or sewer installations along this road. After much discussion, the Trustees would agree to the installation of a water line on the north side of TR 218 provided the line is bored 8' below the bottom of the existing ditch. Flanagan will communicate this to the county engineer.

The 2023 Tax Budget Hearing was held. Stacy moved to submit the 2023 Estimate of Revenues of \$4,315,216 as presented by the Fiscal Officer, to the Budget Commission and to adopt the Estimate of Revenues for the 2023 budget year. Smith seconded. Roll call all yes.

Meeting adjourned at 9:55 p.m.
